Section 1: Terms and Conditions for Applicants

1.3 Conditional Offers

Revision to the date by which offer conditions must normally be fulfilled for postgraduate taught programmes starting in January.

1.11 Changes to Undergraduate and Postgraduate Taught Programmes

Clarification that we may make changes to the availability of modules as well as the balance between optional and compulsory where we consider they will not affect the fundamental nature of the programme:

1.16 Cancellation

Clarification that the 14 day “cooling off” period applies after you have paid your tuition fees for a pre-sessional programme.
